

**Re:** EDC Proposals



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The Educational Development Committee has completed a review of the final proposals for projects to be completed in the 2014-15 school year. The committee of three administrators, three teachers and one community representative has recommended funding three proposals through the funds left in this year's allocation. These projects are based at the secondary level and will support the professional work of seven participants as follows.

- **Introduction to Technology** – to develop a new elective high school course for ninth grade students. It will provide a transition from the middle school Technology program into the high school CTE sequences for Auto Tech & Construction Tech.
- **Junior Level Math Courses** – to begin the creation of a curriculum for the two new math courses designed for third year students to provide additional opportunity for students seeking an advanced Regents diploma. The curricula will combine elements of Geometry, Intermediate Algebra and Algebra II and will focus on common core instructional shifts.
- **Google Classroom Policies & Procedures for AMS** - to create the documents, resources and tools for staff, students and parents to ensure a consistent implementation of Google Classroom. This project will help ease the transition from Edline to new online tools designed to help maximize technology integration for the upcoming wireless environment.
