School Day Schedule:

- Students must be in class by 7:30 am to be considered "on time"

Dismissal Schedule:

- The end of bell rings at 2:10 pm
- Students need to gather belongings and head straight to the Bus Atrium

To Stay After School Students Must...

- stay with their teacher until late busses arrive
- get a signed bus pass from the teacher to ride the bus

- late busses are offered on Tuesday, Wednesday


