- ~Be mindful of time and return quickly to your class
- ~Leave the bathroom the same as when you arrived
- ~Be mindful of others privacy
- ~Use bathroom facilities appropriately
- ~Report problems to staff immediately
- ~ Refrain from using illicit substances (vaping)

IN THE CAFETERIA, STUDENTS WILL...

- ~Wait your turn in line
- ~Pay for all food and drinks
- ~Use manners and be polite to staff
- ~Remain in the cafe
- ~Use school appropriate language
- ~Use a reasonable voice level
- ~Clean your table and area

- ~Remain in the courtyard the entire lunch period/ study hall

- ~Be mindful of voice levels as to not distract surrounding classrooms and offices
- ~Immediately report issues to the main office

- ~Be on time
- ~Sit quietly in assigned seat
- ~Work actively on an academic task

- ~Use ehallpass when requesting to go to another locqtion
