#### NYS MATH ASSESSMENT

The New York State Mathematics Assessment will take place here at AMS on Tuesday, May 7 and Wednesday, May 8th. The exam session will conclude at 10am and a modified schedule will be used for the remainder of the day. Students in Grade 8 will use the Computer Based Testing model required by New York State. Grades 6 & 7 will use traditional paper tests.

Students are reminded to bring:

- Pencils (all students will have access to scrap paper)
- Water bottle
- Pleasure reading book for after their assessment
