What is the spending plan?



District funding for technology originally was set for \$2,160,806. Phase 1 purchases totalled \$1,085,055.



There was no time limit on purchases to be reimbursed by Smart Schools funds



Purchases recommended at this time do not expend all Smart Schools funds



Phase 2 purchases are for security cameras and safety and warning lighting.

Cost for each expenditure:



Phase 1 expenditure (completed):

\$ 1,085,055

- Replacement of switches, including cabling, UPS
- Wireless access points, including installation, licensing, cables
- Distance Learning at AMS
- Design and management costs, contingency




Phase 2 expenditure:

- Security enhancements
- Cameras and lighting
